The long prose-poem Kayak Lessons (Free Books, 2009) is included, as well as the sixty haiku first published as Catching The Light - 12 Haiku Sequences (Cervena Barva Press, 2009). Greinke is equally comfortable with both social protest (ie: Mild Valence, The Vampires) and lyric modes (ie: Persona, Driving North, Clown the Mist). These poems address the struggle of love in a brutally forbidding world, the rift in man's nature and his position in nature itself. An instant classic by one of our best poets.
